We support the children to wash and dry their hands correctly. Staff help the children to practise the skills and posters above the washbasins provide a reminder to them when they are more independent. vears foundation

Children are asked to wash their hands:

- before eating
- after going to the toilet
- after playing outside
- after touching animals.

We do lots of activities with the children where we talk about germs and why we need to wash our hands. These include making posters, simple computer games, learning simple poems and making germ puppets.
